

ENGLISH	<p>Exploring shifts in time In this unit, students will engage with a variety of texts. They will read, view and comprehend familiar narratives with an historical context. Students will discuss characters, setting, events and context in familiar narratives. They will create an adaptation of a familiar narrative, developing and elaborating on relevant ideas from topics or texts.</p>
MATHS	<p>Number and place value - prime and composite numbers; mental and written strategies to solve problems involving all four operations. Fractions and decimals – order, compare, add and subtract fractions with related denominators; calculate the fraction of a given quantity Chance - probability of outcomes as a fraction or decimal Using units of measurement - interpret and use timetables Data representation and interpretation - similarities and differences between different data displays; purpose and use of different displays</p>
SCIENCE	<p>Making changes In this unit students will investigate changes that can be made to materials and how these changes are classified as reversible or irreversible.</p>
HASS	<p>Australia in the past Students will investigate Federation, law-making and Australia’s three levels of government.</p>
HEALTH	<p>Who influences me? In this unit, students explain the influence of people and places on identities. They explore how important people in their lives and the media can influence behaviour.</p>
HPE	<p>Students will practise their ball skills and prepare for the upcoming Cross Country.</p>
THE ARTS	<p>Going to the movies In this unit, students make and respond to music exploring pieces of music that tell a story, and music that appears in film.</p>
LOTE	<p>Me, Myself and I In this Japanese unit, the students will learn everyday greetings and how to describe themselves in written and spoken forms.</p>
HOMEWORK	<p>Reading, Spelling and Maths revision will be the focus for homework this term. Some weeks there will be a special focus. Activities will need to be handed in on given dates.</p>
